To fulfil this role, candidates are required to be:

- proficient in the Maltese and/or English Languages, and
- in possession of a recognised qualification at MQF level 6 or a recognised comparable qualification; or
- in possession of a recognised MQF level 5 certificate in Inclusive Education (such as those awarded for the Supply Learning Educator courses) and a pass (Grade 1-5, Grade C) in 4 subjects at MQF level 3 (O levels) which must include Maltese, English, Mathematics and any other subject, or:
- in possession of a full recognized qualification at MQF level 4 in Health and Social Care, Children's Play Learning and Development, Children's Care Learning and Development and a pass (Grade 1-5, Grade C) in 4 subjects at MQF level 3 which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject, or;
- in possession of any subject at Advanced Matriculation Level (minimum grade E) at MQF Level 4 and a pass (at least at Grade 1-5, Grade C) in four (4) subjects at MQF Level 3, which must include Maltese, English Language, Mathematics and any other subject.
- Be in possession of a clean police conduct.
- Have good references.
