IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Semester 2, covers the period from the 15th of February until the 21st of June, 2024. Registrations are to be submitted by Friday 26th January, 2024. Kindly note that activities are only open to the Chiswick House School community. Registrations will only be accepted with advance payments.
- Extra-Curricular activities are organised by third parties. Registration together with payment is to be made
 directly with the activity organiser as per details provided within this programme. Said third parties
 assume all risk and responsibility for such activities and any matters related to a pupil's attendance and
 participation in such activities, are to be addressed directly with the organisers.
- If the requisite minimum number of applicants for an activity is not met, the activity will be cancelled. In
 that case, payments will be refunded. Furthermore, the school reserves the right to cancel any activity
 when it is deemed that such action is necessary in the best interest of the children. In such a case, a
 refund will also be granted.
- Extra-Curricular activities are held between 14:45 and 15:45hrs for Level 1 to Level 5 pupils. Children will
 be supervised by the activity organiser between 14:30 and 14:45hrs.
- During half days in June, activities for Level 1 to Level 5 pupils will be held from 12:45 to 13:45hrs.
 Children will be supervised by the activity organiser between 12:30 and 13:45hrs.
- Extra-Curricular activities for EY1 and EY2 pupils are held between 14:00 and 15:00hrs.
- During half days in June, activities for EY1 and EY2 pupils will be held from 12:30 to 13:30hrs
- Children must be collected on time. No supervision is provided once the session is over.
- Extra-Curricular activities are held on school days only. Therefore, on public and school holidays, activities
 will not take place. Please refer to the scheduled activity dates overleaf.
- Pupils who are assigned to a Learning Support Educator (LSE) during school hours, may require the same support during extra-curricular activities held at Chiswick House School after school hours. It is imperative that this is brought to the attention of the activity organiser upon registration for any activity so that a way forward can be discussed. Costs related to the Learning Support Educator during extracurricular activities will be borne by the parents/guardians.
- Parents and quardians are not allowed inside the school during any of the activities
- On days when pupils have Extra-Curricular sports activities such as Handball, Hockey, Sports for Growth and Taekwondo, children may come to school in their P.E. kit.
- The Extra-Curricular programme for Semester 1 ends on Friday, 9th February. A new application form would need to be submitted should children wish to particate in the programme for Semester 2.
- Parents are requested to inform class teachers of any changes in Extra-Curricular activities for Semester 2 and consequently update the online collection form to reflect the said changes as of the 15th of February 2024.


